The raffle was conducted by Elvira and Ken.


Tim Donlin won the Club raffle which is a red CGCC windbreaker!


**Susan Bervin** is running for Lakewood City Council and Barbara Rock is running for Lakewood Fire Commissioner.


**Doug Willrich** wanted to thank John Johnson and Gary Pautz and everyone behind the scenes for their work at the 5-star.
